

REGULATIONS

1. All exhibits will be judged in accordance with NAFAS Competitions **Manual 4th edition, 2023. The judge is Mrs Pauline Foster. Exhibits judged Sunday 1st November 7.00am-11.00am.** The judge's decision is final.
2. All classes are open and entries will be accepted in order of receipt.
3. Exhibits must be the unaided work of competitors and be assembled at the venue with the exception of classes 2, 4, 8 and 9 which may be brought completed.
4. All classes may include fresh, preserved or painted material. No artificial plant material or artificial flower forms are allowed.
5. No items to be attached to backgrounds or staging unless stated in schedule.
6. The position of the exhibits will be decided by the competition committee. All exhibits and competitors' property will be at risk of the competitors. Neither Grimsby Flower Lovers nor John Whitgift Academy will be liable for any loss or damage sustained by the competitors. However every precaution will be taken to safeguard competitors and exhibits. All spillages must be cleared up immediately.
7. Staging times between 1.00pm – 6.00pm on Saturday 31st October for all exhibits.
STAGING TIME WILL BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO AND COMPLETED BY 6.00PM.
8. Exhibits to be dismantled after the awards ceremony on Sunday 1st November 2026.
9. Aerosol cans of paint or other must not be used inside the hall or car park.

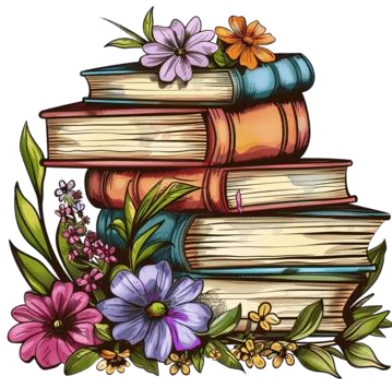

Staged on 90cm circular black disc

Viewed all round and judged from the front

STAGED BY NO MORE THAN TWO NAMED PERSONS

Class 2 Lord of the Rings

An exhibit suspended from a floor standing wooden frame (width 150cm height 183cm)

Space allowed width 50cm depth 50cm drop 120cm to include a loop for hanging

Show committee may offer assistance with hanging the exhibit on to the frame.

A photo of the frame and full staging will be displayed on the club media board and available on request from the secretary.

Viewed all round and judged from the front

Class 3 Two Sides to Every Story

An exhibit with two placements

Space allowed: width 70cm, depth 60cm, height optional

Staged on continuous tabling 74cm from the floor, covered in black fabric

With black background

Viewed & judged from the front

Class 4 The Forager

A Pavé Exhibit

Space allowed width 61 cm depth 61cm height 20cm

Staged on a single black cube which is placed on the floor. The height of cube is 61cm.

Viewed all around and judged from above

A diagram of the cube and full staging will be displayed on the club media board and available on request from the secretary.

Class 5 It's a Fine Romance

An exhibit

Space allowed: width 60cm, depth 60cm, height 95cm

Staged on continuous tabling 74cm from the floor, covered in black fabric with a black background

Viewed and judged from the front



Class 6 What the Dickens?

An exhibit to incorporate the title of a Dickens' novel

Space allowed: width 60cm, depth 60cm, and height 95cm

Staged on continuous tabling 74cm from floor covered in black fabric with a black background

Viewed & judged from the front

Class 7 The Garden Expert

An Exhibit featuring foliage

Space allowed width 70cm depth 60cm, height optional

Staged on continuous tabling 74cm from the floor, covered in black fabric with a black background

Viewed & judged from front.

Class 8 Mark My Words

A craft exhibit in the form of a book mark

Plant material must predominate.

Not to exceed dimension: width 7 cm length 21cm

To be staged on a slope on continuous tabling 74cm from the floor, covered in black fabric with a black background

Viewed & judged from front

Class 9 The Borrowers

A petite exhibit

Space allowed width 25cm depth 25cm height 37cm

Staged in grey alcoves on a table covered in black fabric

Viewed and judged *from the front*

MAY BE BROUGHT READY ASSEMBLED

Class 10 Branches and Blooms Limited to 3 entries per person

Photograph to interpret the title and must include plant material in the photograph.

Judged by Mrs Tina Waller

Images must be no larger than 21 x 16cm (8"x 6") and should be mounted with overall dimensions not exceeding 25 x 20cm (10" x 8"). The competition secretary must receive the photographs in an envelope clearly marked with exhibitors name by Wednesday 21st October 2026
